## Bath

Bath is without doubt one of Britain's, if not Europe's most beautiful and historically intriguing cities. Ideally situated in the lush Avon valley in the rich rolling downs between the Cotswolds and Mendip Hills, the city has been celebrated for centuries for its idyllic atmosphere. Through the ages, writers and artists have come here for inspiration; Charles Dickens, Jane Austen and Thomas Gainsborough have all sung the praises of the city's calm and leisurely air.

Bath's natural springs inspired the Romans to build magnificent temples and baths. The splendid Georgian period transformed Bath into one of the most famous cities in Europe. Architects such as Beau Nash, John Bennett and John Wood built neo-classical parades, squares and crescents from the now renowned Bath stone. The Thermae Spa, having been closed for many years, re-opened in 2006 following a £40 million restoration and redevelopment. **From the East:** Take the A4, at the junction with the Bath exit take the road to Batheaston. Bailbrook Lodge is on the left hand side after 50 yards.

**From the West:** (City Centre) Take the A4 towards Chippenham, at the A46 underpass junction, take the road to Batheaston. Bailbrook Lodge is on the left hand side after 50 yards.

**From the North:** (M4) Come off at Junction 18, take the A46 at the Bath exit, take the road to Batheaston. Bailbrook Lodge is on the left hand side after 50 yards.
